	 Roses, carnations, and bouquets lead the season as part of Valentine's Day. The main destination market is the United States, followed by Europe and Canada.
	Santiago/Chile, February 20th, 2023 – Every year Kuehne+Nagel, one of the world's leading companies in sea and air logistics, positions itself as a key partner for the Latin American flower industry. This period of the year stands out for being the one in which the largest quantity of flowers, especially roses, are exported to key markets such as the United States, Europe, and Canada.
	Flowers are one of the main exported products in Latin America. Colombia and Ecuador stand out as the second and third largest sellers internationally, with 326 and 168 thousand tons, respectively, according to <u>Expoflores</u> ' data, with roses, carnations, and bouquets leading the season. This makes the flower industry an important source of income for thousands of South American families.
	Although this season was not free of uncertainties due to factors such as the weather, Kuehne+Nagel, one of the main leaders in the flower industry, contributed to the mobilization of the largest amount of stems in the aviation sector with the support and participation of its strategic partners.
	According to <u>NRF</u> , Americans spent almost \$24 billion on Valentine's Day last year, with flowers as one of the most popular gifts, with a 37% preference. As part of the strategy, in Ecuador, Kuehne+Nagel increased its warehouse receiving capacity by 36%, improving infrastructure with additional docks and extra refrigerated trailers. It also had the support of an expert and certified team to meet this season's demanding goal.
